PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

The Meeting was held to discuss a suggestion put forward by Mr. Roberts of Essex University to form an Association of University Engineers, the purpose of this Association being to promote, foster and develop the Engineering services function within the Universities of Great Britain.

After lengthy round table discussion, it was agreed that such an association would be an advantage both to the Universities and to the Engineers employed by the Universities to develop and maintain engineering services.

1. IT WAS AGREED unanimously that such an Association be formed, and be given the Title THE ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY ENGINEERS and that those present, with the exception of Mr. Hallett of Manchester University, be members of a steering committee to organise and develop this Association.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION It was agreed that Articles for the Association be prepared by the Secretary and circulated to all members of the Committee for their comments. 4. ENLARGEMENT OF MEMBERSHIP

It was agreed that the Secretary would send a letter to the Engineers-in-Charge at all British Universities advising them of the formation of this Association and Inviting them to participate.
