LOCATION

This year's conference is being held at **The Edge, University Of Leeds, Willow Terrace Rd, Woodhouse, Leeds LS2 9JT**

University of Leeds is based in the north of England. It is easily accessible by road and rail, and is within easy reach of Leeds airport.

By Rail

Leeds Railway Station

Approximately 1 mile from the university campus, Leeds Railway Station is the nearest main line railway station to the venue.

Leeds Railway Station is well connected to major cities across the UK, including regular direct services from London King's Cross, Manchester, Birmingham, Newcastle, Edinburgh, and York.

Taxis and local bus services are available from the station to the university campus, and the journey typically takes around 10 minutes by taxi.

Burley Park Railway Station

Approximately 1.5 miles from the university campus, Burley Park Railway Station serves local and regional routes operated by Northern Rail.

While smaller than Leeds Railway Station, it may be a convenient option for delegates travelling from nearby towns and surrounding areas.

Shuttle Service

A complimentary shuttle service will be provided from Leeds Railway Station to the university campus on Wednesday 9th September, and from the university campus to Leeds Railway Station on Friday 11th September. Further information to follow.

By Air

University of Leeds is accessible from all major airports in the UK. The campus can be easily reached by taxi or public transport from Leeds Bradford Airport.

Leeds Bradford Airport

Leeds Bradford Airport offers regular domestic and international flights and is located approximately 8 miles from the University of Leeds campus.

The airport is well connected to Leeds city centre by public transport, including the Flying Tiger bus service, which operates frequent routes between the airport and Leeds city centre with a journey time of approximately 30–40 minutes, depending on traffic.

Taxi services are also readily available from the airport to the university campus.

Please note that delegates are responsible for their own onward travel from airports.

By Car

The postcode for the university campus is **LS2 9DA**.
